There is so much more to Cambridge than the beautiful lands created at the convergence of two rivers or its logistically perfect location in the heart of Ontario's economic corridor. Cambridge is the coming together of people from diverse, close-knit and proud communities. The people of Cambridge "do the right thing" by respecting history, family values, a sound work ethic, the arts, environment and advancement. A young city, Cambridge is a master of balancing the excitement and promise of the new with the historical significance and stability of the old. A place where coming together is just the start. Uniting together is what sets Cambridge apart. Undiscovered—Cambridge families and entrepreneurs get more for less, and sacrifice nothing.

recreation

Cambridge is home to more than 1000 acres of parkland, with 96 parks, 140 sports fields, over 68 kilometers of recreational trails including many along the Grand River, a Canadian heritage river, including the start of the popular Paris Rail Trail. Known as the "Ontario Recreation Capital", it boasts exceptional organized sporting and leisure activities with ice surfaces, arenas, indoor and outdoor pools and sports fields. Several golf courses are within close driving distance. It is also home to the Galt Arena Gardens, the oldest continuously operating arena in the world.

infrastructure

Cambridge is designated as the first Smarter City for Asset Management by IBM. It's also the first city hall in Canada to achieve gold certification for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) and is committed to build all new municipal facilities or those undergoing renovations to achieve a minimal gold level. Situated along Canada's major highway, Highway 401, Cambridge connects to Toronto, Toronto International Airport and several US border crossings. It is also within a short distance of the Hamilton International Airport (HIA), the largest domestic air-cargo airport in Canada. Cambridge has a well-balanced approach to planning for commercial residential and industrial growth.

arts & culture

A variety of cultural events, including Friday Night Art Live at the Cambridge Library and Galleries, the annual event of the Cambridge Mayor's Celebration of the Arts and many events for the entire family, makes the events calendar an active one. Catch a play or a musical at the Dunfield Theatre located in the historic downtown along the river, conveniently close to shopping and dining. Activities and programs by the Centre for the Arts and the Libraries are available for all ages from infants to seniors. The Cambridge Farmers' Market has been in operation on the original site circa 1830, making it one of the oldest markets in the country.

education

Cambridge is proud to be home to the University of Waterloo's School of Architecture, McMaster University's Teaching Centre at Cambridge Memorial Hospital, Conestoga College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning's School of Engineering Technology and Trades as well as its Institute for Food Processing Technology. It is also within close proximity to Wilfrid Laurier University, University of Guelph, University of Toronto, York University, Western University and McMaster University and several campuses of these and other post-secondary institutions. It also hosts excellent public school systems and many private schools.
